WHEN

WHERE

★ All campuses and Lawrence Berkeley National Lab.

WHAT WE WILL GAIN

- ★ We'll force UC to bargain fairly for job security and pay, as well as health and safety.
- ★ We'll oppose UC President Mark Yudof's effort to re-orient UC towards profit-making and away from public



service with his strategy of permanent downsizing and disrespect of workers' rights.

WHY

★ To force UC to bargain in good faith on compensation, furloughs and the state budget.

UC's UNFAIR LABOR PRACTICES

- ★ Yudof has refused to bargain over budget cuts for state-funded employees. His bargaining team has refused all discussion of alternatives with UPTE-CWA, insisting instead on a blank check to implement layoffs and furloughs.
- ★ UC has refused to bargain over funding that is already allocated in grants for employees' raises.
- ★ UC unilaterally implemented increases to health benefit premiums and transportation rates (see <www.upte.org/rx-tx/ulp>).
