

**HAIMAN LEVIN,  
CANCER VICTIM**

**Mineral Water Manufacturer  
Passes Away After Three  
Months' Illness.**

Death last night claimed Haiman Levin, of 77 Twelfth avenue, a prominent Jewish resident of the city. Mr. Levin was ill for three months with a cancerous growth which it was impossible to check. He succumbed to the disease shortly after 6 o'clock last night, ending a life which had been largely spent in the interest of bettering the Jewish residents of the city.

Mr. Levin came to this country in 1896 and settled in this city, where he has since made his home. For the past fifteen years he has been a lecturer of the Congregation Bnai Israel, having a class which he conducted nightly on Talmud. He continued this until his recent illness made it impossible for him to leave the house.

The deceased was born in Russia and came to this country with members of his family twenty-two years ago. Shortly after settling here he bought out the mineral water business of Richard Warren, on Prospect street, and has since been engaged in that work. He was the senior partner of the firm of H. Levin & sons, mineral water manufacturers, located at 160-162 and 169-181 Governor street. He was a member of the A. M. White lodge, I. O. B. A. order, and of the Congregation Bnai Israel.

He is survived by six children, four sons and two daughters. They are: Jacob H. and Nathan, engaged in business with him; Morris F., a lawyer, of this city; Isaac, Ula and Mrs. Rae Kessler. He was sixty-eight years old. The funeral will be held this afternoon at 1 o'clock from the home, and interment will be made in the cemetery of the Congregation Bnai Israel, in Bergen county.
