

JOSEPH CHLEBNIKOW

To Joseph Chlebnikow, one of Paterson's pioneer Jewish business men and for more than twenty years an active worker in Jewish community affairs, death came this week in the Barnert Memorial Hospital from complications which resulted from injuries which he received when he was struck by an automobile two weeks ago.

Mr. Chlebnikow was widely known throughout the city, especially for his work in the Miriam Barnert Memorial Hebrew Free School and the Paterson Hebrew Free Loan Association, in both of which he was a member of the board of directors. He retired from the millinery business more than ten years ago and since that time he has been devoting his services to Jewish affairs here.

Mr. Chlebnikow left surviving him his widow, Mrs. Cecilia Chlebnikow, a son, Abram, and seven daughters, Eva, Rose, Mrs. William Kleinberg, Mrs. Roman Efros, and Mrs. Jacob H. Levin of this city and Mrs. Richard Cornwall and Mrs. George Reniff of California.
